FISH RESPONSIBILITY

Respect other park users.

Carefully dispose of fishing line
and hooks in a designated
receptacle or garbage bin, or take
them home with you.

Catch-and-release is recommended.
Be sure to safely remove the hook
and line (needle-nose pliers or
forceps are helpful).

Consider using barbless hooks and
artificial lures.

Fish only during daylight hours to
avoid losing your line.
